The Scottish Gaelic Society of Victoria (SGSV), founded in 1905, is a non-profit incorporated association with the objective of promoting "the study and cultivation of the Gaelic language and literature in Victoria".

The SGSV provides both Gaelic and non-Gaelic speaking people, along with those interested in the Gaelic language and/or culture, opportunities for meeting people who share a common interest, communicating with each other and improving knowledge of the Gaelic language and culture.

The activities of the SGSV currently include the holding of classes for the study of the language, a Scottish Gaelic Choir, newsletters, house cèilidhs and other social events.

The SGSV welcomes all Gaelic enthusiasts who have an interest in studying, learning or preserving the Scottish Gaelic language, music and culture, whether they live in Victoria or further afield.

Members receive the Society's newsletter throughout the year. This contains news about members, SGSV activities and a variety of articles about Gaelic and Scottish interests from both near and far. Members are encouraged to participate in, and support, the various activities organised throughout the year, irrespective of whether they can speak Gaelic or not.

Our membership year goes from 1 March to 28 February inclusive, with renewals payable annually.

The cost of SGSV membership is \$25 per person.
